2021-2022 PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Completed projects soared over the past year.

Miami-Dade Beacon Council closed projects with a record 57 companies in 2021-2022 -- nearly an 80% increase vs. prior year.



· Gains were consistent and strong across all MDBC target sectors, which saw at least a two-fold increase of the number of completed projects as compared to the prior year.

Close to 65% of FY21/22's projects were expansions and/or relocations by new-to-Miami companies.

Companies that are new to the Miami market are driving nearly 1,800 jobs, or about 65% of the new jobs created this year.

 New to Miami companies included three Miami - born startups: Alpha International Transport, LandQuire and Xennial Digital.







- number of new jobs rises to 8,000 when indirect jobs induced by this development are factored in.
- Life Sciences & Healthcare and Technology led job creation, accounting for a combined 40% of new direct jobs.

 Creative industries, which includes woman-owned sustainable clothing and textile brand OSOM, led to the creation of nearly 150 new jobs.

Since 1985, The Beacon Council has assisted more than 1,300 businesses, working closely with them to provide free, confidential solutions that are customized for each company's unique needs. In 2021-2022, a recordbreaking 57 commitments were secured from companies looking to expand or relocate to Greater Miami. The companies span diverse markets and industries, producing 8,000 new direct and indirect high-value jobs, and generating more than \$800 million of recurring annual economic impact for Miami-Dade County.

SMALL BUSINESS XCELERATOR A Beacon Council Foundation Initiative

The Small Business XCELerator Program was launched during COVID-19 to support the most vulnerable businesses in Miami-Dade County. The program naturally supplements the existing entrepreneurial support ecosystem by partnering consultants who provide business growth and resiliency strategy services to small business owners throughout the county.
